SELECTION CRITERIA

- 60% Grade 12 academic achievements with both Mathematics and Physical Science at level 5 or above within the Science Field
- 60% average Grade 12 academic achievements for other fields of study
- No Bursaries will be granted to existing students who are not promoted to next year level of study
- Applications from designated groups will be given preference i.e. HDIs
- Consideration will be given to applicants who meet the means test requirements
